- High school semester grades are mailed home during the summer prior to entering ninth grade.
- In order to be eligible for high school semester credit, a student must earn a C- or higher.
- A parent may choose to elect the credit only.
- A parent may choose to also elect the semester grade which is then included as part of the student's cumulative high school grade point average.
